Overview of the Nature of
THAT United's Organizational Development

Churches are Special

They are not just
corporations or institutions.

The Church is the body of Christ

and must maintain and protect the
integrity of all that the holy scriptures
teaches.

In other words, the Church must be *recognized* and *set apart* for its distinctive quality that relates not only to its divine origin, but also to its special function and mission on the earth.

In like manner,
THAT United is an Organism

1. It has a unique source of life
2. Is directed toward particular ends and goals and
3. Is governed by particular commitments and practices...

...such as

- Prayer
- Worship
- Study
- Witness
- And Ministry

Successful churches also stay responsive to external changes and challenges in the environment. For example:

- ❑ Use of Technology
- ❑ Social and political changes
- ❑ Economic challenges

Like other churches of God ...

THAT United is characterized by

1. Human attributes (*organizational environment*)
1. Godly attributes (*spiritual nature*)

The Church of God has a Dual Nature

1. The body of Christ (spiritual management) and
2. A human institution (organizational management)

Church management becomes a challenge of joining together the spiritual and the organizational.

Organizational Design of the Operations of a Church is...

A formally, guide process for integrating the people , information and technology of an organization, which delivers a well-developed operation.

Organizational Design...

Matches the form of the organization as closely as possible to the purpose(s) the organization seeks to achieve.

Organizational Design of the Church is...

Planning that improves the likelihood that the collective efforts of the members will be successful.

In Summary...

- ❑ Identifying the organization's purpose or mission by answering, "Why we exist?"
- ❑ Developing the organization's strategy (plan of action) to accomplish the mission.
- ❑ Build the structure to support the strategy.
- ❑ Create and implement systems that will help keep things running smoothly so that the mission can be fulfilled.

Even the Early Church had a Structure.

In the same manner, THAT United has a structure and chain of command; something that provided the disciples with a “central nervous system” for the growing church.

Yet, the standard for designing
THAT United's organization is
the Holy Scriptures; otherwise the
church will lose sight of its origin
and mission.

Since God is the Author of Government...


He desires THAT United to be well-ordered so that we will be have
